



Subject: Request for Information - Separation of ammonia from sour gas directed after stripping to Claus units at ORLEN in Plock

Dear Sirs,

ORLEN is a leading energy company in Central and Eastern Europe. In Plock, ORLEN operates the largest refinery in Poland, integrated with a petrochemical complex comprising approximately 60 production units located on an area of 800 hectares.

We are seeking information on potential technologies or solutions available on the market that would enable the separation of ammonia from sour gas directed after stripping to Claus units at ORLEN in Plock. An alternative option is the possibility of separating ammonia from sour water prior to the stripping process at Sour Water Stripping units.

The appendix containing the scope of work will be provided after the attached Information Protection Agreement has been signed.

Please attach the Bidder's registration documents to the Information Protection Agreement.

General information required from Bidder:

Therefore, we would like to ask you to provide:

1). Formal criteria 0/1:

- The Bidder shall submit a list of persons duly authorized under powers of attorney to sign the offer (and all documents forming part of the offer) or to perform any other activities related to the preparation and submission of the offer, as well as to undertake all actions and submit all documents related to this procedure, including conducting correspondence via the Connect platform on behalf of the Bidder.
- The Bidder shall submit its official registration documents.

2). Technical criteria 0/1:

- 2.1. The Bidder shall submit information in the form of a presentation concerning the offered technology/solution, which shall include at least the following:**



- basic information, process description, all assumptions, technical requirements (including necessary utility supplies) and any constraints related to the implementation of the proposed technology/solution
- a conceptual process flow diagram of the Bidder's proposed technology/solution
- an approximate minimum time required to complete the task in question
- an approximate cost of the solution

2.2. The Bidder shall submit a list of references relating to the implementation of the offered technology or solution on an industrial scale.

The Ordering Party is seeking technologies with industrial applications enabling continuous operation of installations. The Bidder may also include projects that are currently under implementation.

The Bidder is requested to provide a reference list, for the proposed technology, including the following information:

- location and Client (unless subject to confidentiality restrictions);
- date of implementation, with a clear distinction between installations in operation and those under construction or in the design phase;
- CAPEX value (unless subject to confidentiality restrictions);
- a brief description of each project.

ORLEN would welcome an opportunity to meet with your company to discuss potential cooperation in more detail.

We kindly ask you to submit the required information no later than 4:00 PM on 24 August 2026 via the CONNECT platform.

SUBMISSION RESPONSE TO RFI

- a) In case of interest in participating in the RFI PROCESS, please send the Declaration of Participation by sending a message on the CONNECT Platform within the appointed time limit. In order to send a message, select the "Ask question to ordering party" or "Go to Questions and Answers" button and fill out the question form, then save the question, add an attachment and send a message.
- b) The RESPONSE should be submitted on the CONNECT Platform, by completing all the items in the form and attaching the required information / documents specified in this REQUEST FOR INFORMATION within the required time.
- c) The submitted RESPONSE should be signed by a representative of the Bidder authorized in accordance with the National Court Register / CEIDG or authorized by a relevant power of attorney.
- d) In case of resignation from submitting the RESPONSE, please send a short message on the CONNECT Platform (in the field 'Subject of the message' enter 'Resignation from submitting the offer' and in the text give the reason for resignation and then select the 'Resign' button (the order of actions is important).
- e) Please direct all questions for additional information and clarifications through the CONNECT Platform ("Ask the ordering party" button) within the time limit set in the system. The answer will be sent in the same way.
- f) Subject to point "g)", the content of the questions and explanations of the COMPANY are forwarded via CONNECT Platform to all BIDDERS, without disclosing the source of the question, provided that the questions may be forwarded to the COMPANY no later than 3 business days before the deadline for submission of RESPONSES. After this date, the COMPANY reserves the right not to answer any questions.
- g) If the content of the question concerns a unique solution used by the BIDDER, which cannot be disclosed to other participants of the RFI PROCESS (as indicated by the BIDDER), the COMPANY reserves the right to answer the question only to the BIDDER that asked the question.
- h) The COMPANY reserves the right to refuse to answer questions without giving reasons.

- Scanned technical documents of the RESPONSE listed in **Point 2)** should be attached in item "RESPONSE to RFI - Technical Documents".
